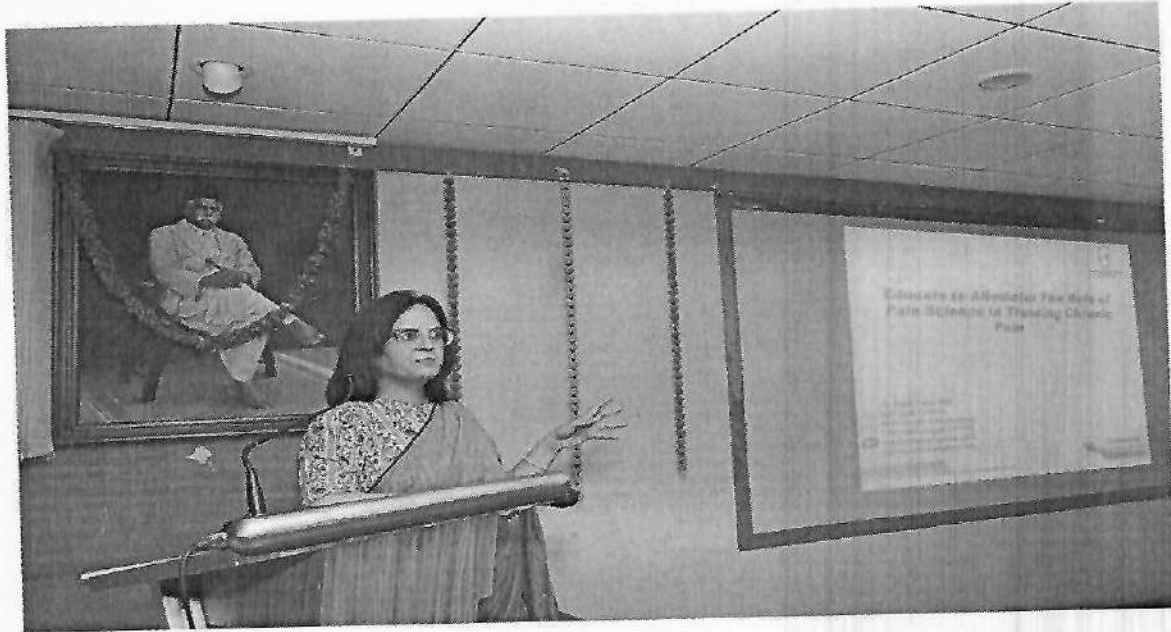

Event Report / Summary:

On the occasion of **World Physiotherapy Day 2025**, observed with the theme "*Healthy Ageing*", the Department of Physiotherapy at Dr. Hedgewar Rugnalaya organized a **Fitness Assessment and Risk Screening Camp** for hospital employees for a week from 8th to 13th September 2025. A total of **173 staff members from different departments** actively participated in the camp. They underwent assessment of vital parameters along with structured fitness tests covering **upper and lower limb strength, endurance, flexibility, gait, and balance**. In addition, risk factors such as obesity, sedentary lifestyle, family history of diabetes and hypertension, low energy levels, and work-related musculoskeletal disorders were screened. The analysis showed that while most employees displayed **good strength, flexibility, and normal gait**, a considerable proportion demonstrated **low endurance capacity, balance difficulties in older adults, and lifestyle-related concerns**. Nearly **56% reported a sedentary lifestyle, 50% had a family history of hypertension and diabetes, 36% were obese, and 35% experienced musculoskeletal complaints**, with many also reporting fatigue at the end of the day. Each participant received personalized counseling and guidance on improving physical activity, posture, and ergonomics to promote long-term health. The camp not only provided an overview of the current health profile of employees but also emphasized the importance of adopting preventive measures early, echoing the global message that *healthy ageing begins with conscious steps taken today*.

Feedback Analysis in brief

The feedback from participants was highly positive. Employees appreciated the personalized assessment, fitness guidance, and ergonomic tips shared during the camp. The awareness lecture on "Smart Posture, Healthy Living" was well received and encouraged many to adopt healthier workplace habits. Overall, participants expressed interest in having such wellness initiatives conducted regularly.

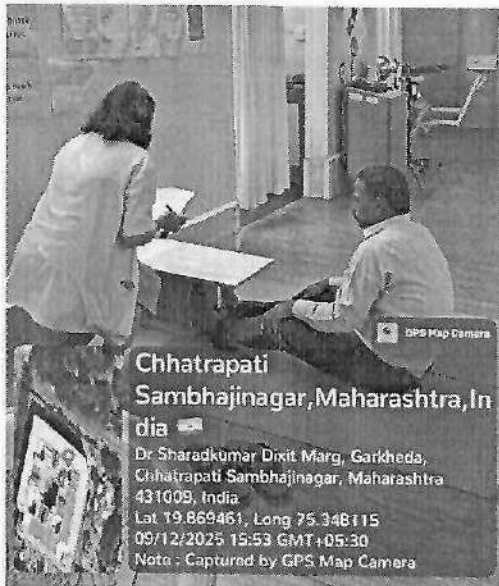


The talk was well-received, with positive feedback from listeners appreciating the informative and accessible content.

Anti-Ragging Awareness

Speaker: Dr. Neha Pujari

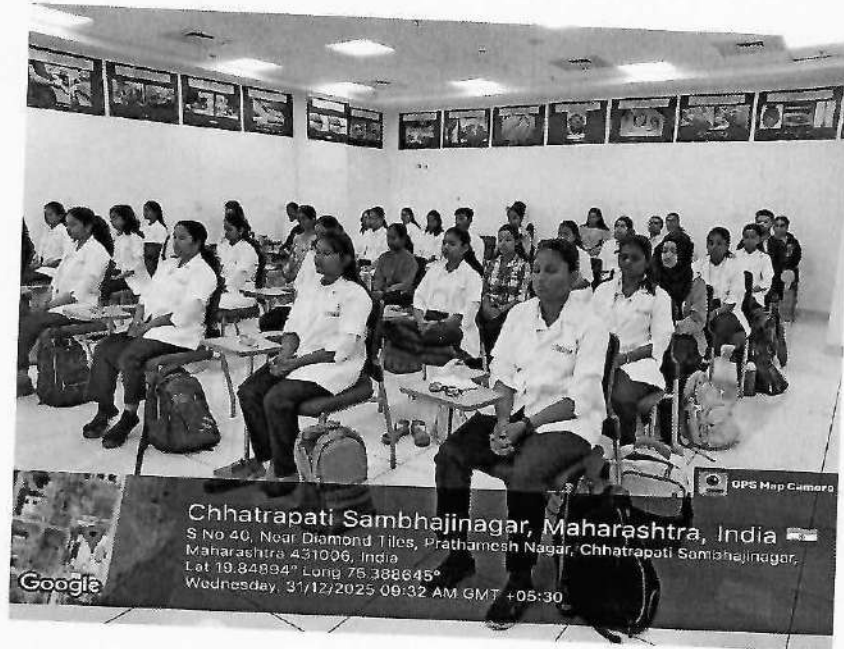
